

Peace between Israel and Palestine

A therapeutic proposal

Essential for lasting peace is that both sides will be satisfied. In order to be satisfied, the Palestinians will need to have their own state. How could they get it? They won't get it by just claiming it, but they will get it by heeding the following therapeutic suggestions, because the resulting behavioral changes will enable the Israelis to concede that state to them.

In their conflict with this Jewish “people of the book” the Palestinians will have to take into consideration one of the most important biblical principles of justice, “an eye for an eye”, which is meant to avoid vengeance with its ever-increasing claims and damages in unending vendettas. So far, the Palestinians interpreted “an eye for an eye” in a quite hostile way. As a matter of fact, they had not been willing to allow the Jews to recreate their biblical state after the UN had voted for dividing Palestine in 1947. Consequently, “the people of the book” did not want those who had refused them to build their state on that territory to live there in peace themselves. Hence, the suffering of the Palestinians.

But what could bring them fulfillment of their deepest longing, their own state of Palestine? They would first need to fulfil the deepest longing of the Jews, namely, to be welcomed in their ancient biblical homeland, even though this land had, for well over a thousand years, served as the homeland of the Palestinians. Once offered that welcome, the Jewish people could share the territory and accord a state of their own to the Palestinians, as a logical consequence of “an eye for an eye”.

How could the Palestinians ever agree to something as counterintuitive as this? By recalling the most important pillar of justice in Islam, which is compassion. By exercising compassion the Palestinians would be able to feel the pain of the Jewish people, persecuted and deprived of a homeland for nearly 2000 years; in so doing they could honor themselves by offering the Israelis a true welcome and allow them to rebuild their biblical state on part of its onetime historical territory, which is Palestine – and not see their return as nothing but a variant of European colonialism.

Both sides will then be able to live at peace side by side – in truly honorable peace.


